Color, Thread & Free-Motion Quilting: Learn to Stitch with Reckless Abandon

Stippling and stitch in the ditch are machine quilting go-to's with good reason. Let's let our foot loose and explore fun free-motion stitching. We will play with design, thread, fabric and batting to create some fun, one-of-a-kind quilts. This class focuses on trying new-to-us motifs, using our imagination and going for it with machine quilting on a domestic sewing machine. This is suitable for an advanced beginner/intermediate quilter.

A few days before the class I will send out a pdf with two or three options for the quilting design you will work on during class. We will take 30 minutes for lunch around 11:45 central and at least one other 15 minute break during the afternoon because we all need coffee. Part of the class is lecture/demo and part stitching.

SUPPLY LIST:

2 - 20" x 20" solid, mottled or batik quilt squares

1 or 2 - 20" x 20" piece of batting - wool or silk and this can be paired with a layer of low loft cotton

Thread:

Please have a variety of weight and color - you do not need to have all of the thread but it helps.

Polyester 100, 60, 50, 40, 30 Cotton 80, 50, 40, 30, 28, 12 silk 100, 60

Needles:

Microtex: sizes 70 and 80

Top Stitch: sizes 70, 80, 90 and 100. Get the 100 if you are using a 12 weight

SewLine or Bohin Marking Pencil with lead color visible on your particular fabric.

Hand Stitching Needles and Needle Threaders
